




As well as units of measurement that measure things like weight, length and capacity (such as metres, kilograms and litres), units of

measurement can also include measures of time.


How would you describe each of these measures of time?






















- Seconds are a very small measure of time.
- There are 60 seconds in one minute.
- There are 60 minutes in one hour.
- There are 24 hours in one day.
- There are 7 days in one week.
- There are around 30 days in one month.
- There are 12 months or 365 days in a year.





Do you know how many weeks there are in a year?

The way we measure days, weeks, months and years is all set by the solar system. A year is the length of time it takes for the Earth to travel around the sun and a day is how long it takes the Earth to rotate once on its axis.





Can you explain what this diagram is showing?




It takes 365.25 days for the Earth to travel around the sun. This is how

many days there are in a year.





Days are relatively short periods of time and years are very long so we split a year into weeks and months too. There are 12 months in a year. There are also 52 weeks in a year and 7 days in each week.









This table shows how many days there are in each month. All the months have 30 or 31 days in them, apart from February which has 28 days in most normal years but 29 days in a leap year.

It takes the Earth 365¼ days to orbit the sun. To make this easier, we round it down and say that a year has 365 days. However, every fourth year we have an extra day, 29th February, to make up the four quarter days that we have missed. The year this happens is called a leap year. Leap years have 366 days.



October comes after September. Good job!




How many days are there in June?

Leap years occur every four years. Good stuff!




Which day of the week comes after Tuesday?











Wednesday comes after Tuesday. Marvellous!




How many days are there in December?
