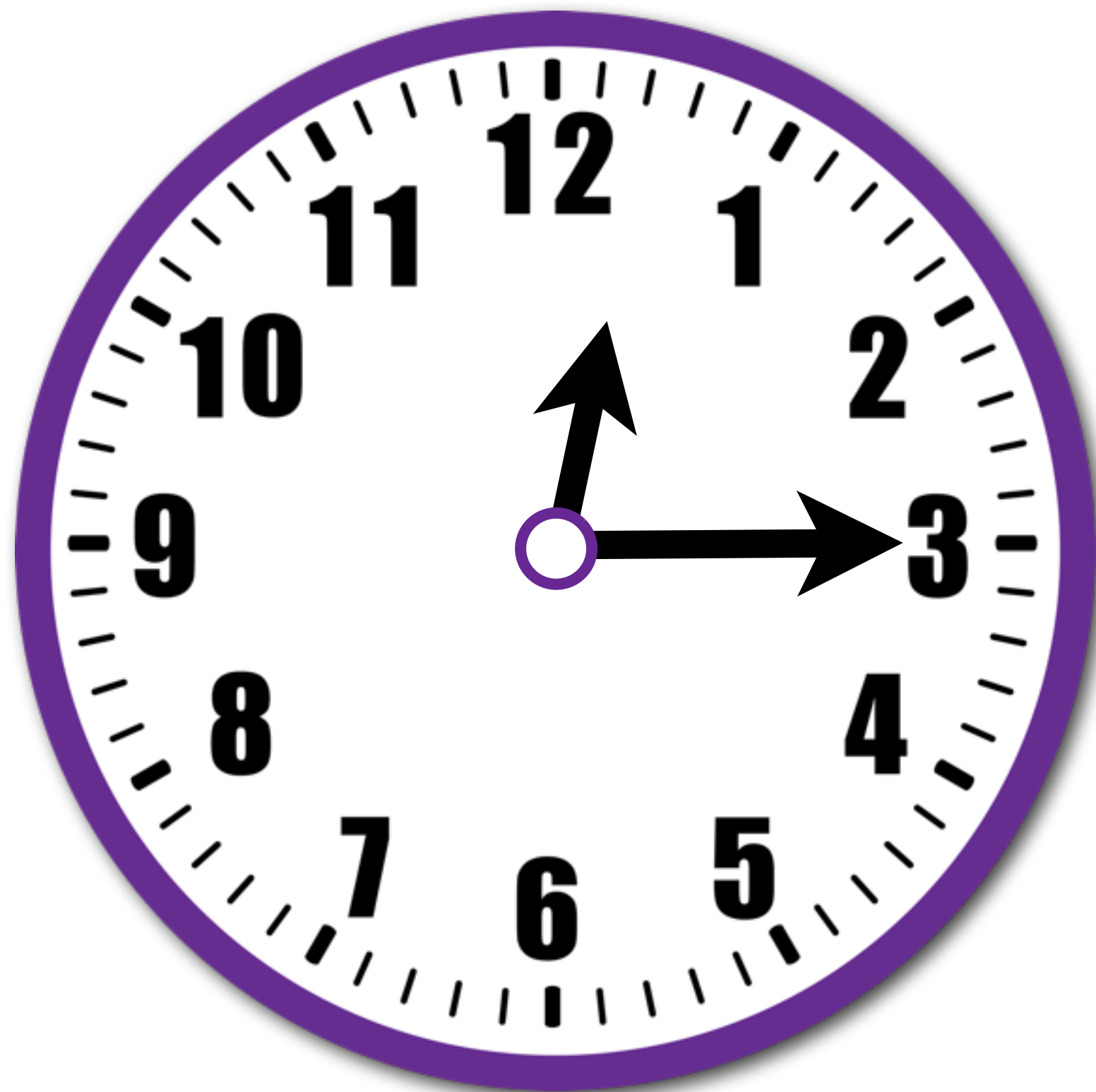

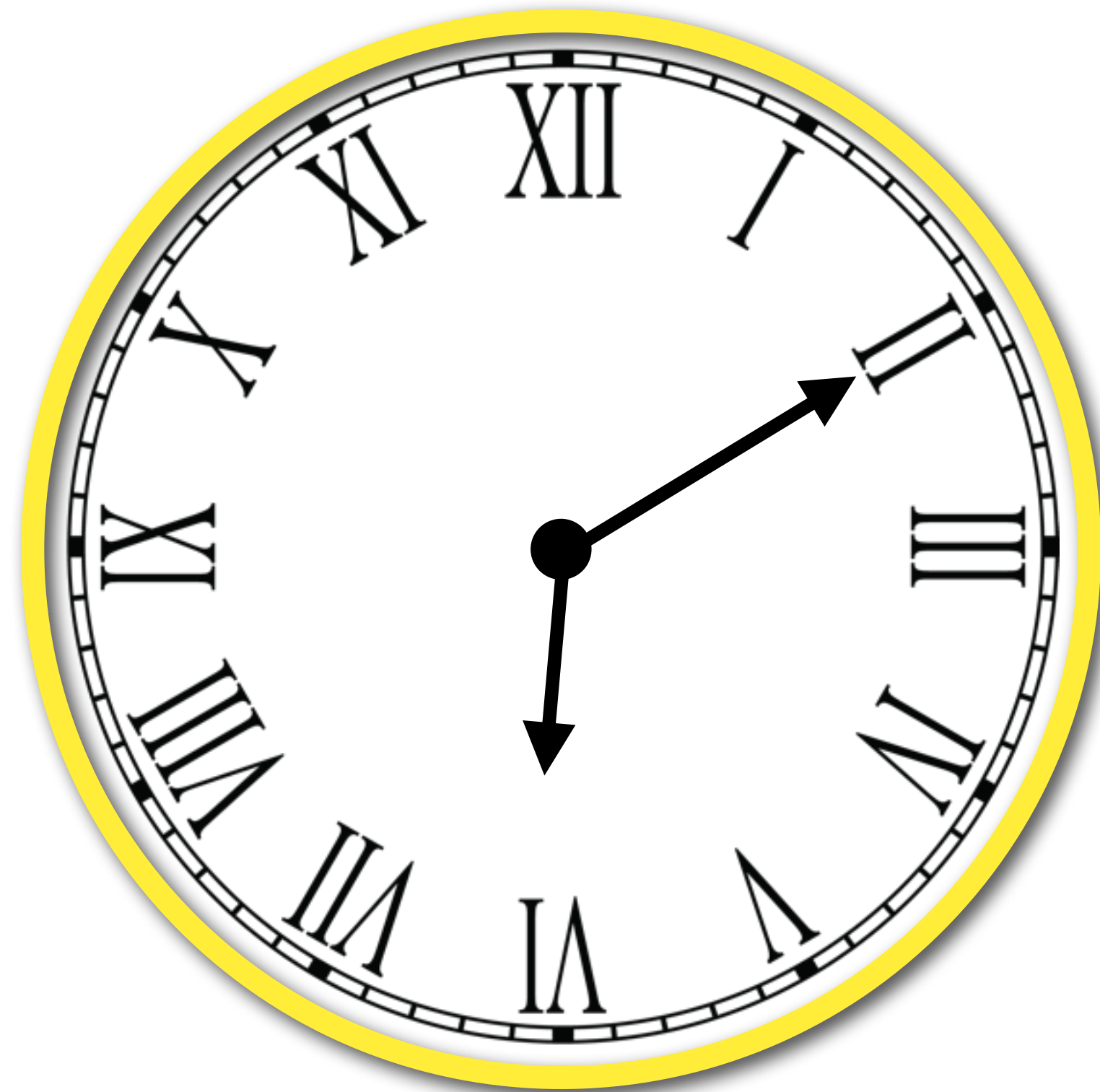

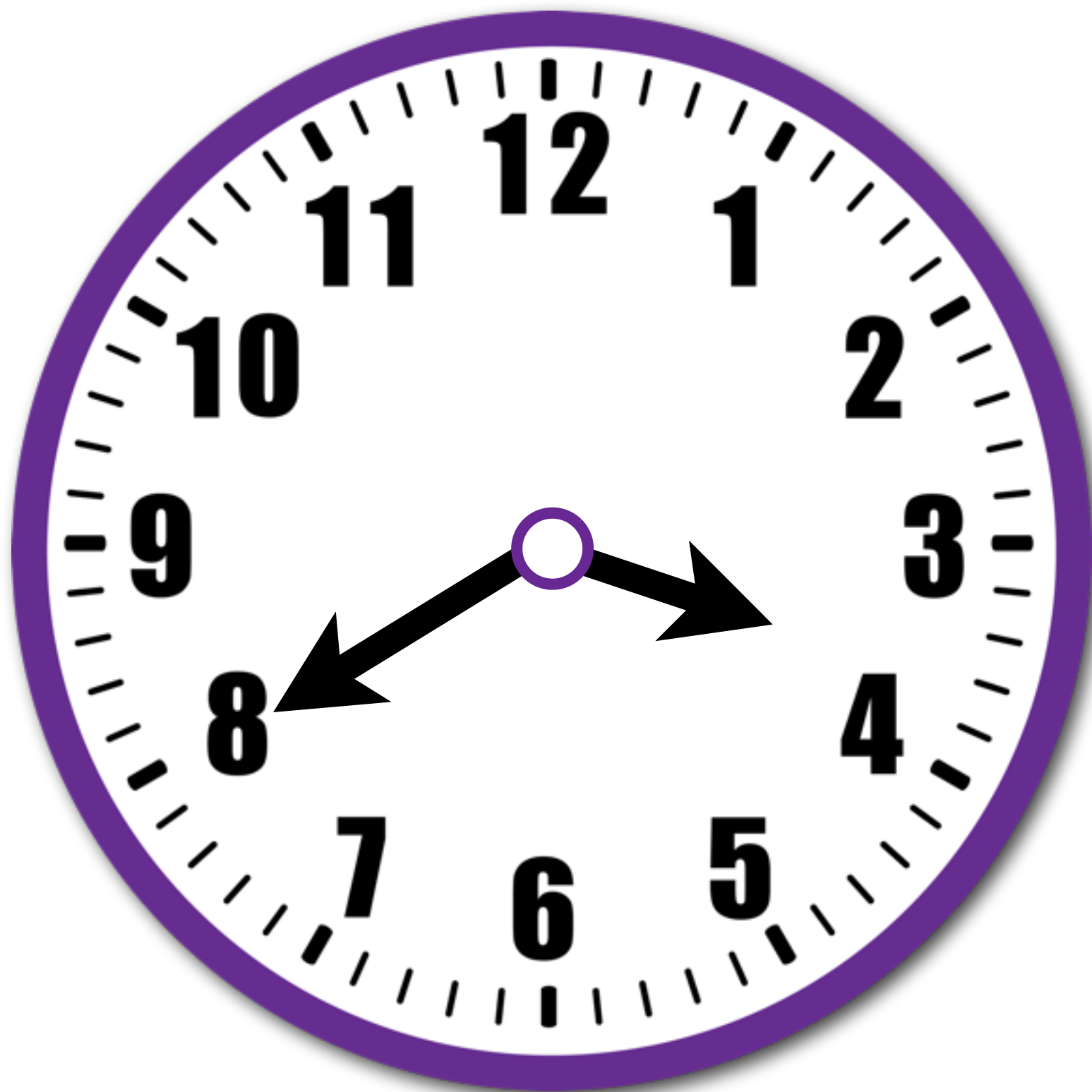
I'm having some problems telling the time. I think the time is 3 o'clock but I'm not sure. Can you help me?

Telling the time is so confusing! Why is this time **10 past 7** when the minute hand is pointing at the 2 and not the 10? Why is it not 2 past 7?

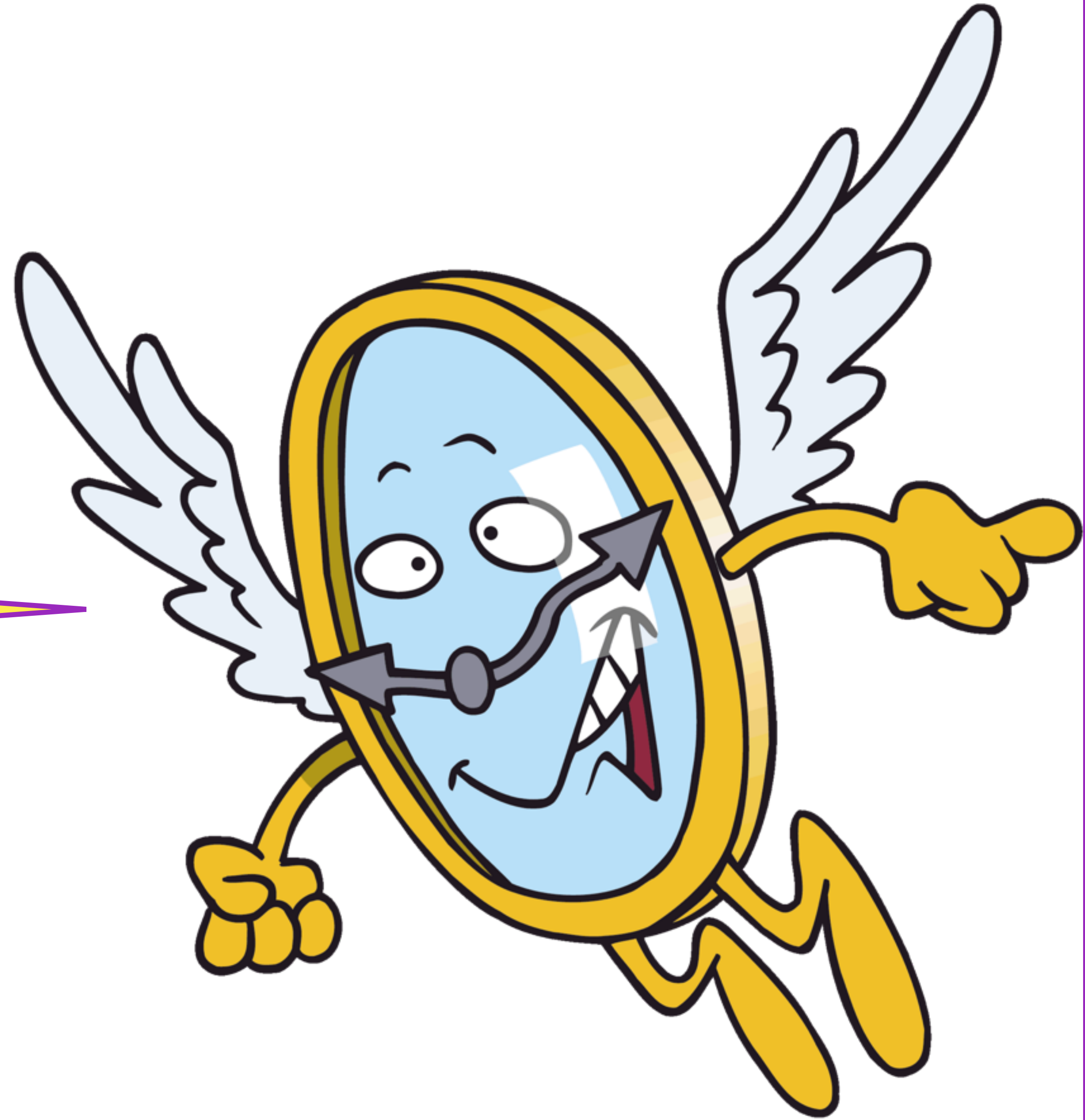




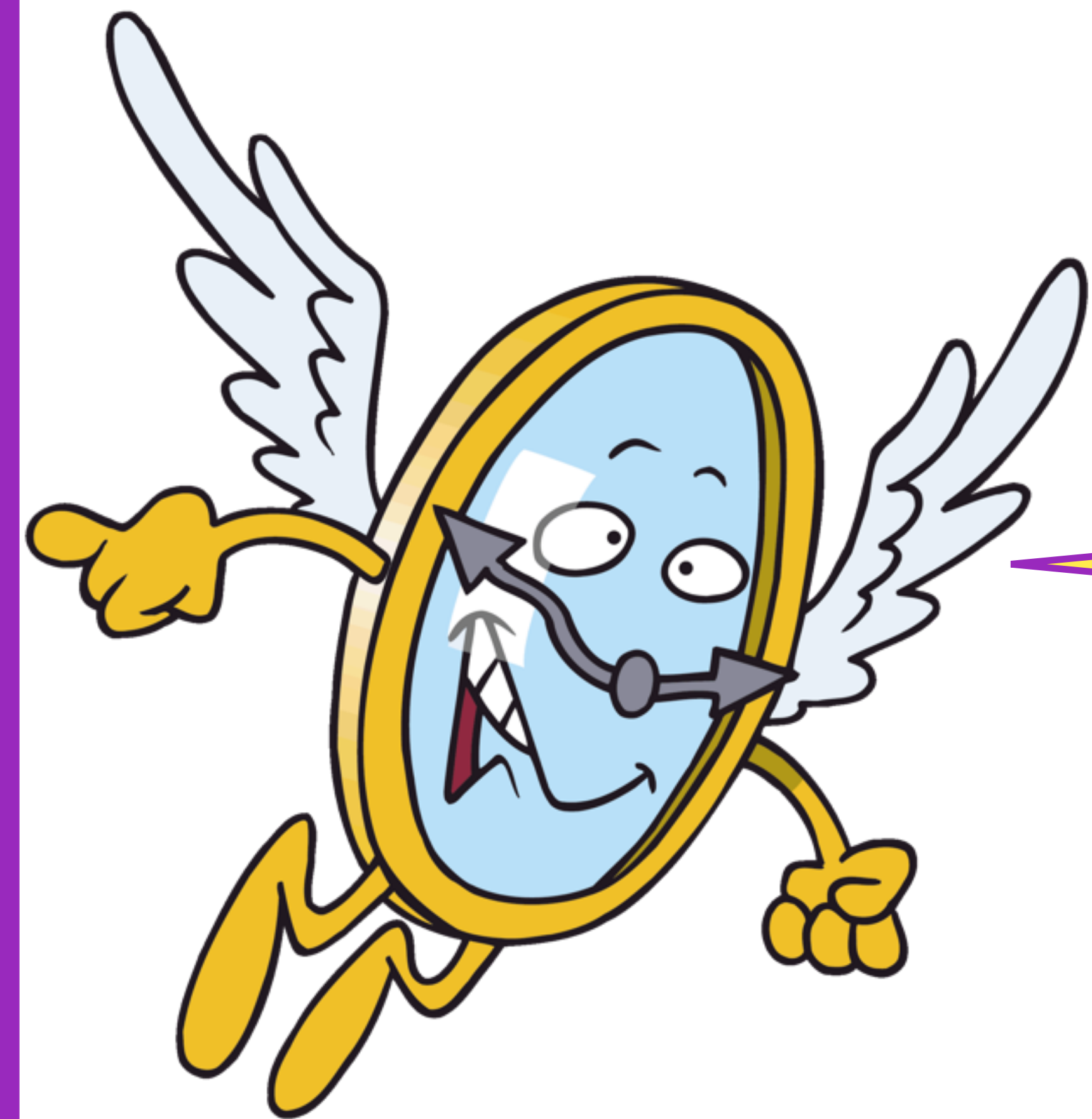
