How to make a Roman numeral clock

1. Photocopy this sheet onto card.
2. Cut out the clock face.
3. Cut out the minute and hour hands.
4. Carefully pierce a hole through the centre of the clock and through each of the white holes in the hands.
5. Attach the hands to the clock face with a split pin so that the hands can spin around.
6. Stick the Roman numerals onto the correct spaces on the clock face.
7. You now have a Roman numeral clock!
